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Thrive is back for the Autumn Term.

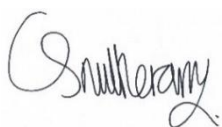
Thrive will be on Wednesdays. We will tweak the school day so that academic learning finishes at 2.25pm meaning that from then, every student in Glebelands will partake in an enrichment activity of their choosing which will finish before 3.15pm - the end of our normal school day. We are offering a **five-week** Autumn Term 1 enrichment programme with the options outlined in the attached booklet. We think that with these opportunities, there will be something for every student at Glebelands and we would like to encourage you to try something that you haven't tried before.

On top of **Thrive**, we will still be running our usual enrichment programme. PE will still be running their after-school clubs and fixtures details of which can be found on the school website. Current extra-curricular activities such as Lego Robotics, DofE, Homework Club, Drama and Music and our academic programme, whereby we spend some sessions after school helping students catch up if they're behind, will also continue unabated.
